



Onsite health services suspended

Due to the systemwide increase in COVID-19 cases driven by the Delta variant, the following onsite services have been suspended until further notice:

- Mobile medical vans (for hearing tests, vision tests and respirator-fit tests)
- Voluntary health screenings offered by BNSF's Wellness team
- In-person/hands-on CPR and AED training

Until these onsite services are available again, you can make an appointment through the BNSF clinic network for all required hearing, vision and respirator-fit tests. Please visit your primary care doctor for routine health and preventive care screenings, which are typically covered at 100% by your health insurance plan when in-network. Online training is available for CPR, AED and first aid training.

Making an appointment at a BNSF network clinic for required hearing, vision and respirator-fit tests:

- For an FRA hearing-vision test and hearing tests only, call LHI at 888-634-1121
- For respirator fit-test, call CHS at 877-780-2673

Registering for CPR, AED and first aid training:

To access the online course, first contact your local safety leader or supervisor. He/she will:

- Submit a [Service Request Form](#) to purchase employee vouchers (\$64 each) for the American Red Cross online "Provisional" Adult CPR/AED/First Aid training course
- Allow up to three business days for the American Red Cross to process your paperwork
- Once the unique voucher number is received, access the provided link to complete the three-hour online training course
