iGTB app coming to TYE iPads soon

Shortly after the first of the year, we'll will implement the iGTB app to enable the delivery of General Track Bulletins (GTBs) on TYE iPads. What's particularly important about iGTB is that it allows BNSF train crews to receive updates on GTBs during their trip.

In addition, when utilizing the iGTB app, crews will be able to fully utilize the portion of SSI Item 18 Electronic delivery of Information which can help prevent the need to stop a train if the PTC system becomes inoperative.

In 2022, iGTB will become the primary means for all TYE employees to access and maintain directives while on duty. GTB access through the MTR application will become a secondary source.

The iGTB reference document provides a glimpse into what train crews will see inside the new iGTB app.

Here's a quick look at what's to come with iGTB:

- Dashboard that provides train crews a summary of GTB content for their train
- · Ability to access individual GTB items for detailed reference
- Refresh button to retrieve any new GTB information delivered during a trip
- · Added colors and shading to make new or voided items more visible
- · Ability to provide in-app feedback to support future version enhancements
- Training will be self-directed and accessible on TYE iPads

Additional information will soon be shared with Transportation teams about when the iGTB app will be available for download and where you can access training to support use and navigation.
