## Class I Railroad Worker Reports Two Trip Wires Anchored to Track Spikes Near Harrisonville, Missouri

The affixing of these wires – difficult to find even when looking for them, much less see while performing professional duties along the right-

On Friday, August 19, 2022, a rail worker discovered two trip wires – one high, one low – anchored to track spikes and signage along the right-of-way near the town of Harrisonville, Missouri. The wires were marked with yellow tape by responding local law enforcement officers for photographic record purposes for the investigation of the incident. The area at which the wires were affixed is in relatively close proximity to a homeless encampment.

Of note, during the past year, no discernable trend or pattern of similar reported significant safety or security concerns pertains in railroads' reporting of wire-related incidents and offenses at or near their property – either in Missouri or nationally.

Missouri have reported a total of 26 significant security concerns. While most of these have involved tampering and vandalism, some have entailed threats, weapons findings, and risk of harm to people or property.
